Minutes Nordic Meeting 2007 Hotel Sofitel/Brussels 2.-4. November

Present:

1. Welcome

Bent Magnussen welcomed and a short presentation of the new delegates from the federations this year.

The meeting continue Sunday 4th November, for a short closing/adjustment of the race calendar to avoid conflicts to EFRAs Race Calendar decided at their meetings.

2. Reports from Nordics 2007

The meeting 2006, decided only to run Nordic Championships in the following classes 2007: 1:8 and 1:10 Track IC and 1:8 Off Road. All championships were held in Sweden.

From Sweden there was given a small report from those events.

Väst8: It was good races with good weather. Two drivers attended for the first time at the race. There will be natural to have some experience before attending a Nordic, and maybe the federation shall give some signals to their drivers to at least have race-experience before attending such races to avoid problems.

Skarpnäck: The track was really good after three days, and a lot of racing. It was a good and fair race, with a lot of participants.

3. Matters discussed:

From Norway: The respect of the race calendars must be better. Norway had to cancel the EFRA GP Touring Car indoor, because Sweden and Denmark had national races in their race calendars at the same time. In Scandinavia we must do better to take care of the international races. Jon-Åge Olsen from Norwegian Motorsport Federation and the organizing club Borg Mini Racing Club explained. This is also a problem concerning how the EFRA race calendar is done. Maybe there must be other routines inside EFRA when the dates for their races in several cases are known to late for the national planning of their indoor races.

From Norway: Norway has increased the numbers of drivers in Large Scale and wants to take part of organizing Nordics in those classes. Finland informed same, and there was decided to re-organize the plan for the Nordics 1:5/1:6 Large Scale. Norway will organize their first Nordic in those classes in 2009, and Finland in 2011. The plan will be updated and enclosed the minutes.

4. Rule Proposals

No proposals arrived before the meeting.

There was a small discussion how to organize the order of racing Nordics between the countries when a class i.e. not are being raced one year.

The discussion ended with the conclusion to update the rules with to say: When the meeting decides to not race a Nordic, the plan for the Nordic only will be paused, and the organizer not passed in the plan (no jumping).

5. Race Calendar 2008/2009

Discussion matter from Sweden: 1:10 El. Touring races Nordics both indoor and outdoor. Indoor attend a higher number of drives, when outdoor is problem to get enough starting. Shall we continue with both indoor and outdoor for this class? There was decided to only run indoor Nordic 1:10 El. Touring 2008 and not change the plan for organizing Nordics.

From Finland: Want to apply for EFRA GP combined with the Nordic 1:10 Buggy. All agrees to run the Nordic for those classes 2008 as an "Open Nordic Championship" with EFRA GP-status if given this status at the EFRA AGM meeting. This mean i.e. if the winner of the race is from England, he/her also will be given the title "Nordic Champion".
